Coalition to Salute America's Heroes Presents \$4,980 Grant to Help End Veteran Homelessness in Arizona

MESA, AZ (February 6, 2013) – The Coalition to Salute America's Heroes (Coalition), a leading non-profit organization dedicated to rebuilding the lives of severely [wounded veterans](#) of the War on Terror, today presented a \$4,980 grant to the Arizona Coalition to End Homelessness (AZCEH), specifically to support the group's initiatives to provide housing for homeless veterans.

“We believe it is a national disgrace that so many of America's brave men and women are returning from the War on Terror, often severely injured, without the resources necessary to support themselves and their young families,” said David Walker, President & CEO of the [Coalition to Salute America's Heroes](#). “Our donation to AZCEH will go directly to meeting the needs of wounded veterans throughout Arizona that deserve so much more from us than homelessness.”

The Coalition's \$4,980 grant will enable AZCEH to furnish approximately 60 housing units that will be occupied by the veterans.

“We are honored that a national organization of the Coalition's stature has recognized our efforts to improve the lives of Arizona's veteran community,” said Joan Serviss, AZCEH Executive Director. “We will put these funds to work immediately to help end the scourge of homelessness among our wounded warriors.”

The Coalition to Salute America's Heroes, based in Leesburg, VA, has provided an invaluable lifeline to thousands of America's wounded veterans since its establishment in 2004. The Coalition is distinguished from other veteran-focused organizations by its direct financial assistance to America's wounded heroes. Its Emergency Financial Aid program has stopped foreclosure proceedings on veterans' homes and kept their vehicles from being repossessed. The organization regularly provides gift checks to cover meals, medical and utility bills, clothing, car repairs and even baby diapers.
