Whether they lost a limb, suffered a traumatic brain injury (TBI), were badly burned, or have another disability, such as posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD), these brave veterans deserve not only to be honored for the sacrifices they made in defense of our freedom,

but they also deserve help in rebuilding their lives. Through financial donations to the Coalition to Salute America's Heroes, corporate sponsors, individual contributors and others have a chance to show their support for our troops as they transition from the battlefront to the home front. Our mission is to help disabled veterans and their families of the Global War on Terror recover from their injuries and illnesses, and to inspire other organizations and the general public to participate in this effort.

What We Do

The Coalition to Salute America's Heroes provides direct financial assistance, supportive services and transitional opportunities to disabled veterans, their families, related military agencies and like-minded non-profit organizations, through the following programs:



EMERGENCY FINANCIAL AID With these funds, we help severely disabled veterans meet a wide range of day-to-day financial needs – particularly if they are waiting for their disability benefits to begin or have lost income because their spouse or parent had to quit working to become their primary caregiver. Most often, this aid is used to cover urgent expenses such as:

- ★ Utility bills
- * Car payments and repairs
- ★ Medical bills

- ★ Mortgage and rent
- * Food, clothing and gas
- ★ Home repairs

HEROES THANKING HEROES This program recognizes that many severely wounded veterans are unable to work outside the home, and that their spouses often must stop working to assume a caregiver role. To help them earn much-needed income the program provides:



- Part-time, flexible employment making "thank you" calls from their homes to Coalition donors.
- ★ Basic training and experience working in a "virtual call center," which also prepares them for other jobs.

CONFERENCES & RETREATS A core part of our mission is to encourage hope, healing and re-connecting. We strive to create life-changing experiences for our severely wounded veterans and their families from all across the U.S. as they continue on their road to recovery. **Heroes Freedom Weekend** (HFW) is a retreat that presents extraordinary opportunities for veterans to develop stronger bonds with their spouse, build camaraderie and tour some of America's most sacred and historic landmarks.

The Road to Recovery Conference and Tribute (R2R) is a multi-day educational and motivational event for wounded veterans and their families to enable them to approach the future with hope and to be better prepared for the challenges that lie ahead. Experts from government, private sector and other veteran-focused non-profit groups and corporations offer advice and guidance on: career counseling and transition, caregiver support, family counseling, enhancing personal relationships and improving mental health and wellness.

HOLIDAY GIFT CHECKS The Coalition distributes thousands of gift checks to disabled service members for meals during the Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter holidays. The Christmas Secret Santa program also provides gift checks to hundreds of disabled veterans every year to help them meet their basic living expenses and buy gifts for their families.





RECREATIONAL OUTINGS AND EXPEDITIONS The

Coalition organizes sporting events, outdoor expeditions and a host of activities that provide wounded veterans time to recreate and interact with their peers who are also overcoming their injuries.

PUBLIC INTERACTION The Coalition informs millions of Americans about the needs of our veterans and how they can help through its direct mail program. The Thank You card program distributes hundreds of thousands of cards each year to wounded

troops. We also encourage the public to petition the government for more adequate financial assistance and timely treatment for injured service members.

PROGRAM GRANTS The Coalition provides direct funding to thousands of wounded veterans in need, and also offers grants to other organizations that support disabled veterans and their families in a variety of ways. We have a dedicated committee that reviews monetary endowments to other groups.

GIFT IN KIND Our relationship with other non-profit organizations allows us to be the key factor in facilitating the disbursement of donated goods from corporations.

VETERAN CIRCLE NETWORK A free membership program designed to provide a network for America's combat-wounded troops. Qualified members receive numerous benefits including: being eligible for holiday meal and gift checks, receiving monthly updates of events and employment opportunities, discounts, free access to online training and the ability to communicate with other disabled veterans in a private environment.

VETERAN'S CAREGIVER ALLIANCE The Mission of the Veteran's Caregiver Alliance is to improve the quality of life for the caregivers of our combat-wounded post 9/11 Veterans. We accomplish this by guiding our caregivers through all services available, while identifying and filling gaps in services. We work with like-minded VSO's, government agencies, and community initiatives, to assure the needs of our caregivers are being met, both privately and publicly. There are many benefits of this free program including; a peer support network, discounts, scholarships, online education, financial coaching and more.




Obtaining Help

If you are a wounded veteran interested in seeking help from the Coalition to Salute America's Heroes, all that's necessary to begin the process is to visit our website, **www.saluteheroes.org**, and complete an online application.

The primary guidelines to be eligible for assistance are:

- ★ You must have a service-connected disability rating of 30 percent or greater resulting from a single, sustained injury incurred during combat in Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation New Dawn or Operation Inherent Resolve, or in support of these conflicts.
- ★ Your information will be verified by the General Services Office of your respective military branch and by the Veterans Administration or the Department of Defense.
