THE BAUGHMAN FAMILY

My name is Joseph Baughman. I am married to Tonya. I am alumni with the Wounded Warrior Project and was looking for employment that would work with my disability. They referred me to the Coalition and the fit was perfect. Once I started working with the Coalition I found out it was a good fit for my wife as well, so she joined the team too. Together we have two kids; Aiden who is 10 and Gabriella who is 8.



I SERVED 15 YEARS

in the Marine Corps retiring in 2013. I have done 3 combat tours; 2 to Afghanistan and 1 to Iraq. The extent of my injuries is all mental. I suffer from extreme PTSD and anxiety. I was on the frontlines throughout the battle of Fallujah, Iraq in 2004 and was exposed to what I call hell on earth. I was engaged in various operations in an extremely hostile environment.

THE ENTIRE BATTLE WAS A BLUR TO ME,

constantly being engaged in firefights, sniper fire, indirect fire, and IEDs minute by minute, hour by hour, nonstop.

My recovery has not been easy. There are a lot of things I used to be able to do that I can't, as well as things I have now that I never had before. I have a psychiatrist and therapist I have to see regularly. I am not able to attend any types of events that have lots of people (indoor and outdoor.) I can only go to stores at certain times of the day. I am always on high alert and watchful of everything that is going on.





WHILE MY RECOVERY IS ONGOING

it does affect my wife and kids as well. My loving wife helps me day in and day out with little things around the house as well as when a trigger is hit. My kids are slowly starting to understand my actions, thought processes, and limits.



I am blessed to have found the coalition to Salute America's Heroes. It has given me the opportunity to spend more time with my family by working from home. I have met some great people and opened my circle of trust a little bit. It has even given my kids a chance to meet and interact with other kids in the program who live similar lifestyles. America's Little Helpers is fantastic. My daughter has already done a zoom meet and greet with other kids in the program and she loved it. We also did a family puzzle together, which was one of the recent events offered.


