I JOINED THE NAVY AS A CORPSMAN IN AUGUST 2008.

I was a petty officer 3rd class when I got out in December 2013. My husband, Steve Bultje, joined the United States Marine Corps in 2007, shortly after graduating high school. Steve went on to deploy twice to Afghanistan, ultimately getting injured in the Sangin District in 2011.

HE WAS ONLY 21 AT THE TIME OF HIS INJURY.

Steve was injured on March 5th when he was attacked by a Taliban improvised explosive device while on a foot patrol. He required over a dozen surgeries and the physical and mental toll was difficult. I had just been reassigned from Okinawa Japan to work at Portsmouth Naval Hospital when I met Steve on Easter day April 24th, 2011. I was an active-duty Navy Corpsman and was put on a weekend watch at the Patriots inn. We stayed together through all the surgeries and eventually both got out and started our family.

Currently we live in New Braunfels Texas with our two kids Kyle, and Avery. My husband is currently working as a dental hygienist where he loves his job and his patients. He went from shooting rocket launchers in the Marine Corp to cleaning teeth and providing patient care. Last time I did this newsletter, I was an HTH call rep making calls and thanking our amazing Donors. In May 2022 I was hired on as a Team Lead position and have since been a manager of my own team. Having a team of my own has been such a great experience. Advancing in the Coalition to Salute America's Heroes family has been an honor and I really do feel like we are all family.

Even though he is physically doing better, we still have several dates throughout the year that seem to bring us back in time. Losing his friends at such a young age has remained such a painful experience and I know this is a similar feeling shared by many veterans across the US. Our kids get to hear stories about these amazing men and we make sure they are always remembered. Steve is also so moved by the sacrifice of his brothers

and uses this as his motivation to thrive and enjoy his gift of life.





My family and I have a lot to look forward to this year. Two significant events are in store for us in 2023. My husband and I will be celebrating our 10th wedding anniversary and we will be celebrating our son Kyle's 10th birthday. Steve and I have been looking forward to this anniversary for a very long time as a chance to renew our vows. Our original wedding was cancelled in lieu of a more intimate ceremony as Steve required his right leg amputation surgery that same week. It's amazing to think of what we have been through and accomplished since that day. We look forward to many more memories in the new year.


