Coalition to Salute America's Heroes Moves HQ to Williamsburg

Leading not-for-profit serving combat-wounded Veterans relocates home office from Washington, DC area

WILLIAMSBURG, Va. (Sept. 5, 2023) – The <u>Coalition to Salute America's Heroes</u> (Coalition), a leading not-for-profit organization dedicated to rebuilding the lives of severely wounded veterans of the global War on Terror, announced today that it has moved its corporate headquarters to Williamsburg.

The Coalition has been based in Leesburg, Va., for the last 10 years, and will continue to maintain a presence in the area, which is also home to three members of its Board of Directors.

The organization's new offices are housed in Jamestowne Professional Park at 1769 Jamestown Road, Suite 109. Williamsburg's only comprehensive executive park is both colonial and modern, with its brick Georgian buildings nestled in a park-like setting, surrounded by towering oak and poplar trees.

"The Coalition looks forward to many productive years operating in historic Williamsburg, which offers a most appropriate venue for patriots who have sacrificed for their country," said David W. Walker, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Coalition. "We have great respect for the rich military history of this area, and we look forward to meeting many of our new neighbors and other like-minded citizens who wish to join our mission and serve alongside us on behalf of America's combat-wounded Veterans."

Among its many activities, the Coalition has hosted annual marriage retreats for combatwounded Veterans and their spouses in Williamsburg over the last three years.

Since its establishment in 2004, the Coalition to Salute America's Heroes has provided an immediate, invaluable lifeline to thousands of America's combat-wounded veterans. The organization is distinguished from other veteran-focused groups by its direct financial assistance to America's wounded heroes. Its Emergency Financial Aid program has stopped foreclosure proceedings on veterans' homes and kept their vehicles from being repossessed. Its innovative Heroes Thanking Heroes program provides transitional, part-time, flexible employment to nearly 50 combat-wounded veterans or their primary caregivers, enabling them to make phone calls from their homes, usually to personally thank donors for their contributions to the Coalition.
